FIRST AID MEASURES

- Swallowed:** Induce vomiting and force patient to drink large volume of water. Use fingers in the throat, Ipecac Syrup APF or similar emetic. Do not attempt to give anything to a semi-conscious or unconscious person. If diarrhoea is absent, give saline cathartic such as Epsom salts or milk of magnesia in water. Seek medical attention.
- Eye:** Hold eyes open and flush with large quantities of water for at least 15 minutes and consult doctor.
- Skin:** Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with plenty of soap and water.
- Inhaled:** Remove victim to fresh air. Seek medical advice.
